

Fish Facts

Fiscal Year 2010

- Fish served an average of **1,423 people** each month.
- **Thirty percent** of those receiving emergency assistance were **children**.
- Fish provided **147** households serving **389** people with energy assistance.
- Fish provided **67,092 services**. Most people need more than one kind of service during a visit.
- Fish supplies three to five days of nutritious, emergency food. This translates into **169,533 meals**.
- Fish also provides clothing, personal care products, household utensils and goods, and information & referral services. Fish also provide rent and utility assistance as funds are available.
- Fish will provide service every four months; more frequent services are available with a referral.
- **795 volunteers** contributed **17,983 hours** of service to our community through Fish.
- 89% of all contributions goes to our program services; 11% goes to administration and fundraising.
